





The PSAC provides subject matter expertise on concepts, policies, procedures, technologies, and operational methods developed in support of the FirstNet network. Its perspective helps ensure necessary operational constructs are met for critical first responder communications.

- 44-member committee with public safety and state/local/tribal representatives and non-traditional first responders
- Led by seven-member Executive Committee
- Bi-monthly webinars on essential topics related to network, products, and devices, plus in-person meeting(s) each year
- Operates Tribal Working Group to provide advice on tribal outreach, education and consultation

**FirstNet: The Network** 

#### AT&T

The First Responder Network Authority is responsible for overseeing the creation and delivery of FirstNet – the nationwide public safety broadband network. An independent entity within the Department of Commerce's NTIA, the FirstNet Authority ensures AT&T delivers on the terms of its contract and deploys a network that meets the needs of public safety now and into the future. FirstNet is a nationwide wireless broadband network for first responders being built and deployed across all 50 states, 5 U.S. territories and the District of Columbia. FirstNet offers public safety a communications network built and customized to meet their needs. AT&T is responsible for building, operating, deploying, and maintaining the FirstNet network in accordance with a 25-year contract with the FirstNet Authority. As part of this agreement, AT&T gains access to 20 MHz of federally owned spectrum and \$6.5 billion in initial funding, and it will invest about \$40 billion over the life of the contract to establish the network.




